TITLE: Lab Technician REPORTS TO: Technical Manager

PURPOSE: Responsible for performing packaging testing according to ISO/IEC17025 requirements, laboratory QSPs and

SOPs, and using cGLP / cGDP

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Direct, hands on contributor
- ▶ Manage projects from start to finish, meet deadlines and client commitments
- Perform package testing including transportation simulation, climatic conditioning, accelerated aging, and integrity inspections (bubble leak, dye leak, peel strength, visual, dimensional measurement, etc.)
- Prepare job paperwork
- ► Receive samples including preliminary inspection for damage, sorting, counting, labeling, measuring, weighing, and preparing units for testing
- Setup climatic conditioning chambers with supplied profiles, place samples in chambers, record transaction information on job router
- Put samples into Accelerated Aging chambers, record transaction information on job router, provide dates and times to supervisor
- Perform transportation simulation including drop testing, box compression, vehicle vibration, and impacts
- ▶ Monitor vibration table schedule, turn boxes over during run, save equipment records to job folder
- ▶ Bring samples into Controlled Environment Room, unpack samples, mark and label inner packaging, stay organized
- Subject samples to variety of integrity inspections that may include bubble leak testing, dye leak testing, cutting / prepping specimens, measuring peel strength, measuring dimensions, etc.
- ► Record all information / data entry on appropriate job paperwork including router and data sheets (may need to develop custom data sheets during a project)
- Author test reports and submit to management for review
- Repackage and prepare samples for return shipment to client
- ► Must get appropriate QC checks and sign-offs throughout a project
- Must complete daily "Standard Work" duties at beginning and end of shift
- ▶ Daily monitoring of circular chart recorders and change charts each week
- Perform preventative maintenance on test equipment that may include cleaning, lubricating, tightening, etc.
- ► Follow all company policies and procedures
- ▶ Use good laboratory practices (GLP) and good documentation practices (GDP) at all times
- Other duties as assigned

ADDITIONAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- ▶ Some customer interface may be required
- ▶ Ability to lift boxes (up to 30 lbs) and use pallet jacks to move materials
- Safety awareness, take precautions and be vigilant of others' safety
- Actively seek laboratory technical personnel certifications with the support of laboratory management
- Career progression opportunities available based on achievements and demonstrated work ethic

- ▶ Minimum HS diploma or equivalent
- ► At least two years in technical or quality field preferred
- Some college, associate degree, or bachelor degree preferred
